



Website Privacy Policy

Introduction

At Active8 we value the young people we support, their families, our staff, volunteers and supporters. We always endeavour to comply with the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and other relevant legislation.

This policy explains how we collect and use the personal information you provide to us. By using our website, any of our services, or providing us with any personal information we will assume you are agreeing to your information being used and disclosed in the ways described in this policy.

Active8 is a registered charity (registered in England and Wales: 1163942). We are a Cornish charity which aims to empower and motivate young people, aged 14-30 years old, who have a physical disability.

Active8 Online Privacy Statement

This privacy and data policy sets out how Active8 uses and protects any information that you give us. Active8 is committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected. This Privacy Statement applies only to information collected through our website and not to any information collected offline.

Your consent

By using our website, you consent to our Privacy Statement.

What Information do we collect from our website?

Active8 is committed to protecting your privacy. We only receive information from you when you make a donation, fill out a form on-line, or via cookies, which are implemented should you wish to do so, to help speed up future navigation (see cookies section below).

When filling in a form, as appropriate, you may be asked to enter your name or contact details, you may however, visit our site anonymously. When making a donation, your personal data will be protected by both the donations service provider and Active8's data protection policy.

What do we use your information for?

When you provide us with your personal information via our website, we will treat that information in accordance with this Statement and current UK Data Protection legislation. Any of the information we collect from you may be used in one of the following ways:

- to process donations
- to respond to your feedback or information request
- to collect non-personally identifiable information to provide statistics and feedback on the usage of the website via Google analytics.

Your information will not be given to any other company for any reason, without your consent. We do not share your data with anyone else or any other organisation unless it is necessary for the purpose for which you have given us the data.

How do we protect your information?

We have in place a variety of security measures to maintain the safety of personal information. We keep your data secure in our database with appropriate security mechanisms in place including encryption, limited access and passwords as appropriate.

How long will you keep my information?

We will retain your information for as long is necessary for the relevant activity, and meet any legal or regulatory requirement. If you cease to have an active relationship with Active8 or request to receive no further contact, we will retain some basic information in order to avoid sending you unwanted materials in the future, and to ensure that we don't accidentally duplicate information.

How can you access your personal information?

GDPR states you have the right to request a copy of the personal information we hold about you. This is known as a Subject Access Request. How can you amend or remove your personal information?

Cookies

Cookies are software files that are stored on a computer or mobile when an individual visits a website. We are required by EU law to use cookie notification. Cookies allow websites to recognise that a user on an individual computer has previously visited the site. You will be asked if you wish to use cookies when using our website. We do not use the information for marketing purposes. We do make use of Google Analytics cookies to report non-personally identifiable visitor information to other parties for statistical reporting.

Embedded content from other websites

Pages on the Active8 website may include embedded content (e.g. videos, photos etc). Embedded content from other websites behaves in the exact same way as if the visitor has visited the other website. These websites may collect data about you, use cookies, embed additional third-party tracking, and monitor your interaction with that embedded content, including tracking your interaction with the embedded content if you have an account and are logged in to that website.

Your rights

The law requires us to tell you that you have a variety of rights about the way we process your data:

- ✓ Where our use of your data requires consent, you may withdraw this consent at any time.
- ✓ Where we rely on our legitimate interest to process data, you may ask us to stop doing so.
- ✓ You may request a copy of the data we hold about you.
- ✓ You may change or stop the way in which we communicate with you or process data about you, and if it is not required for the purpose you provided it, then we will do so.
